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2022-2023 TRANSPORTATION APPLICATIONS FORMS

Yellow bus applications will be done online starting **May 1st for the 2022-2023 school year**. All eligibility rules still apply. This process will involve using School Engage through your Powerschool parent account to apply for busing. The 2022-2023 online form will be **active on May 1st** and will be the only way to apply for yellow busing. Paper forms will no longer be available or accepted once this new process begins so please ensure you have a Powerschool account. Below is a link to the new

Please note that just like in previous years, applications that are submitted online after June 24th will not be processed until school staff are back in late August. Specialized busing (for the Pathways Program) will still be done with paper forms through the school. Please contact Sandy for further information.
