

PowerSchool portal they will need to be added before they may start the Brightspace process. Schools are JUST beginning to use BrightSpace as a communication tool so be patient as staff learns this new tool as well. As your student(s) travel through the grades in RDPSD, they will access the features within the BrightSpace Learning Management System more and more. When a parent logs in, they will have access to all of their children regardless of the school they attend. This will be another great communication tool for schools and parents.

ROAD SAFETY

The school office fields at least 2-3 phone calls per month with other parents or OP community neighbors complaining about unsafe driving habits when parents are dropping off or picking up their children.

As much as we encourage all parents to follow basic road safety and rules, we are not the Police or By-Law enforcement. All we can do is respectfully remind parents to please consider the safety of our children, siblings, families and community members as you drop off and pick up your child. We do contact the City of Red Deer By-Law Enforcement &/or the RCMP when flagrant disregard for the rules are observed. We are then at the discretion and timing of these outside services to deal with an enforcement concern.


