I'll start this month with a huge shout out to the students & families of OP! We had some on the fly changes through the month of September with regard to C-19 restrictions, masking, cohorting, etc. Our District and the Board of Trustees faced some tough decisions in the absence of guidance from AHS & the Gov't of Alberta. In the end, we received similar guidance to masking and cohorting that we were mandated last year, so with our staffing configuration, educational supports and our focus on academics, teaching and learning, we then implement what is best within each school in Red Deer Public and within OP School.

To the staff at OP - thank YOU for all that you do each and every day to help keep our students safe and keep them engaged & learning in the classroom(s). Our staff has been diligent in ensuring that the start up at Oriole Park was filled with fun, engaging activities and welcomed students back into the classroom(s) so they could have a wonderful start to their year. Our "soft start' and staggered entry contributed to this and hopefully made the transition a little easier for all.

BUS ZONE - NO PARKING

Please note:

We have moved our Prairie Bus drop off & pick up to Oleander Drive. There is NO PARKING along that street during our busy morning and afternoon school bus times (8:30 - 9:00 am and 3:15 - 3:45 pm) This will ensure we have room for the 3 Prairie buses that service our students and families.

We will have the City of Red Deer put up the School Bus Zone sign, but so far, that sign has not been installed. We try to get our Bus Parking Only sign and pylons out each morning and afternoon, but sometimes, things don't go our way! We appreciate your help by keeping this area clear of parent vehicles for the safety of our students.

Reasons for this move:

- students are closer to school entrances upon arrival and if the bus is late, eliminates additional delays to get into classes
- students are closer to buses at end of the day in the event they are late out of the classroom
- students on AMA Patrols are closer to the buses after their patrols are done
- additional teacher supervision, if needed, at the bus zone area with Grade 1 & Grade 4/5 teachers
