

Within two weeks of registering, you will receive a letter with camp information and a mandatory waiver form. The waiver will collect all information required to attend camp. This form must be submitted for your child to participate in the camp.

If a medical condition requires special attention or caution (such as nut or bee allergies), please notify the Camp Coordinator prior to the camp start date. Please note that RDC will attempt to accommodate any campers with special needs. Any camper requiring special needs should notify the camp coordinator well in advance.
